Director's Report: NTC Grants – Carol reported that we were successful in being awarded a grant

for an ad in the Nebraska Travel Guide and for 12 months of banner ads on

VisitNebraska.com. The amount of the grant is \$5,250.00

The High Plains Historical Society was also successful in their grant application to develop a website that Carol prepared. The amount of the grant is \$3,750.00. **Prairie Chicken Dance Tours** – As the season approaches Carol reported that the majority of the tours are filling up. There may be the need for additional

drivers for the tours. Carol may be reaching out as the need arises.
